Colcombe House Roaring Rocks 2014 Vintage 6% abv (Hefs)

Farmhouse "off-dry" style cider. Made entirely from apples grown and pressed in their orchards.

Dawkins Bristol Cider 4.8% abv (Somerset)

Produced for us in Somerset using 100% apples grown in long-established local family orchards.

Dorset Nectar Old Harry Rocks Vintage 6% abv (Dorset)

A vintage dry cider with good tannin, fresh tasting, smooth mouthfeel and matured to perfection.

Once Upon A Tree Crooked Branch Dry 5% abv (Hefs)

Bittersweet toffee apple and apple skin with a hint of cut grass, soft tannins and a lingering crisp, dry finish.

Purbeck Joes Sweet 4.5% abv (Dorset)

A blend of traditional fruity cider, that produce a sweeter cider life.

Snails Bank Very Perry 5% abv (Hefs)

Fruity medium Perry with a complex yet balanced flavour. Made from Stinking Bishop pears.

Thistly Cross Whisky Cask 6.9% abv (Scotland)

The first release from our barrel-aged range; matured in Whisky Casks from Glen Moray Distillery.

Dawkins Azacca 4.5% abv (L) HAZY GOLD, FRUITY, HOPPY

Azacca, named after the Haitian god of agriculture, is a hop big in citrus and tropical fruit notes. Bold, fruity and hoppy beer. Unfined.

Dawkins Bristol Best 4.0% abv (L) COPPER, MALTY, SMOOTH

Classic West Country best bitter with hearty, malty background. Notably well balanced with malt and biscuity tones, satisfyingly bitter finish.

Dawkins Bristol Blonde 3.8% abv (L) PALE GOLD, CITRUSY, FRESH

Multiple Award-winning best seller. The mouth is filled with vanilla malt and left with a long and satisfying bitter finish. An easy-drinking "session beer" with a character.

Dawkins Elderflower Blonde 3.8% abv (L) BLONDE, JUICY, FRAGRANT

Very refreshing small-run pale beer brewed with American Cascade and Amarillo hops for a citrus-scented, fruity aroma and flavour and infused with freshly picked elderflowers.

Dawkins Ekuanot 4.5% abv (L) HAZY GOLD, LEMON, PINE

Made with the new single varietal fragrant American hops. Complex tropical fruits, pine and pepper notes in perfect harmony. Unfined.

Dawkins Resolution IPA 5.0% abv (L) HAZY GOLD, RICH, HOPPY

Triple American-hopped recipe using Cascade, Chinook and Centennial varieties. Rich and full of luscious tropical fruit flavours. Unfined for yet more flavour.

Good Chemistry Time Lapse 3.8% abv (L) COPPER, MALTY, BITTER

This style of beer isn't a showy scene-stealer, and nor should it be. It's a beer brewed with British hops

Naylor's Citradelic 4.4% abv (W Yorks) GOLD, CITRUS, FLORAL

Golden, pineapple and citrus fruit-scented, lightly malty American-hopped pale ale.

Purity Pure UBU 4.5% abv (Warks) AMBER, MALTY, BITTERSWEET

A distinctive, full flavoured beer with a sweeter finish. Brewed with English Maris Otter, Crystal, and Wheat malts, with Pilgrim and Cascade hops. Winner of seven awards.

Robinsons Hoppy Wan Kenobi 4% abv (Lancs) GOLD, LIGHT, FRUITY

Loaded with cascade and sovereign hops, and interlaced with light citrus aromas, this 4% ABV limited-edition golden ale is dangerously drinkable.

Severn Double Hop 4.2% abv (Glos) GOLD, MANGO, FRUITY

Hopped in the boil and during fermentation, with Ahtanum hops all the way from New Zealand and the wonderfully aromatic Simcoe hop, to produce a flavour sensation.

Stealth Covert 3.9% abv (Wilts) HAZY GOLD, TROPICAL, FRUITY

A duo of citrusy hops gives this pale session ale a mouthful of grapefruit, lime and mango. Unfined, Vegan & Hazy. This is the new name for Kennet & Avon brewery.

Tiny Rebel Chocolate Stay Puft 5.2% (Wales) DARK, RICH, CHOCOLATEY

Chocolate marshmallow Porter. They've smothered the biscuit and marshmallow foundation of the original Stay Puft with a glorious chocolate layer, like a liquid tea cake!

Dawkins Miner's Gold 4.4% abv (L) GOLD, FRUITY, ROUNDED

Well-balanced beer brewed with English Bramling Cross hops for a slightly spicy, fruity aroma and flavour. First brewed just for the pub, now sold regionally as 'Bristol Gold'.
Designed for Donnie at The Miner's Arms, St Werburghs



Dawkins Easton IPA 4.4% abv (L) HAZY BLONDE, CITRUS, PINE

Originally brewed as the house beer for our Leith venture (known there as #6 IPA). Australian Galaxy and US Mosaic hops for a truly refreshing citrus-scented taste. Unfined.
Launched by Laurence at Steel Coulson Tap, Edinburgh



Moor Raw 4.3% abv (L) HAZY AMBER, MALTY, HOPPY

Layers of herbal dry-hops over a rich malt base really transforms a traditional best bitter into something unusual and distinctive. Unfined.
